As part of the administration of said funds, proposals are required to maintain a pool of possible providers, evaluation and acquisition of the following specialized professional and consulting services related to said federal funds.

1. ADVICE AND SUPPORT FOR THE ELECTRONIC SYSTEM (CUSTOMER DATABASE)

For the case management of participants and clientele served by the Workforce Development of the Local Area Northeast (WDLAN). You will need to provide advice on statistical quality control related to the clientele as defined by WIOA. Have previous experience in the implementation, development, support, and advice of the systems described above. Experience and knowledge of execution standards and its operation as well as the interrelation of this matter in the handling of cases. Mastery of the concept of the Single Management Center and having the ability to train the human resources that work every day with this matter and board members. The proposal must contain the hourly fees. Development and maintenance of the WEB page and services integrated with our reporting systems. Must have proven experience in programs under the WIOA Act.

2. MIP ACCOUNTING SYSTEM AND CLOSING OF THE FISCAL YEAR

Proponents must have experience and proven capacity in the MIP and FAS GOV Accounting Systems; They will offer advisory services, carry out follow-up tasks through support and training for personnel. Also include services to carry out the closing of the current fiscal year. The proposal must contain the hourly rates.

3. MAINTENANCE AND TECHNICAL SUPPORT FOR INFORMATION SYSTEMS (MIP)

Including, but not limited to, providing maintenance at the operating system level to computer equipment, technical support for problems at the hardware level, detection of problems and/or recommendation of solutions, technical support, maintenance, and monitoring of networks for the communications between offices and configuration maintenance and knowledge of equipment and programs for data backup. The proposal must contain the hourly rates. Services will include updating regulations and personnel processes.

5. WIOA TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Bidders must have experience and proven capacity in the Programs related to WIOA and with other state, federal and/or municipal funds related with workforce development. The activities for which a proposal is requested are the following: (a) technical assistance in matters related to the programs, activities and services that are developed in the Local Area, (b) technical assistance in the preparation of the Quadrennial Plan, Regional Plan, Work Specifications, and respective modifications and (c) technical assistance in the identification of funds to develop activities related to the development of the workforce. The services may be offered to the Mayor's and Local Board, as well as to the local area's management and technical staff. The proponent must include in their proposal their professional profile, previous experience as an advisor, and the hours to be charged.

6. LEGAL CONSULTANCY

Offer legal advisory services on matters related to human resources and administration. Proponents must have experience in the regulations and application of the municipal code of Puerto Rico, Law 107-2020, and other related legal matters.
